Public Art in Sunnyvale *Element: Grove* by Stephen Galloway



Element: Grove by Stephen Galloway was recently installed at Grove 221, a new office building currently under construction in Sunnyvale, CA. This site-specific artwork made of ceramic fit on glass is 30' high x 135' wide. It floats in front of and screens two floors of the building. Visible from both inside and outside, the abstracted image of a walnut tree pays homage to the abundant fruit and nut groves that populated this particular site as well as the region once known as the Valley of the Heart's Delight and now called Silicon Valley.

Medical Oncology/Infusion Center San Rafael, CA



Chandra Cerrito / Art Advisors was invited to develop an art program in a newly constructed facility that offers cancer care services in the North Bay. To complement the center's healing context, soothing colors and imagery of nature were predominant themes. From sprawling painting installations in the reception and corridor, such as one by Mel Prest shown here, to unique zen-inspired photographs in the infusion area, the art provides patients and visitors with a pleasant and relaxing environment.

Medical Clinic San Jose, CA



Since 2016, Chandra Cerrito / Art Advisors has been pleased to place art in the San Jose location of one of the largest cancer community health centers in the country. Most recent additions to their collection include pastel drawings, acrylic paintings, photographic prints, and a nearly 10-foot long wall installation by artist Klari Reis, who creates sculptural paintings within petri dishes. The diversity of media and imagery among the collection parallels the clinic's multilingual staff that offers multi-culturally sensitive health care in the South Bay.
